

**Sri ShenbaghaLingeswarar Public Charitable Trust, Shenbagham
Estates, Madhampatti, Coimbatore – 641 010**

Notes on activities of the Trust

The newly created “Sri ShenbaghaLingeswarar Public Charitable Trust” was registered on 30th November, 2022 at the Sub Registrar Office, Thondamuthur, Coimbatore. The Trust applied for Registration u/s 12A of the Income Tax Act and was granted Provisional Registration vide Unique Registration No. ABFTS7614EE20231 dated 29.04.2023 by the Commissioner of Income Tax (Exemptions). Application was also submitted for Approval u/s 80 G of the Income Tax Act and was granted Provisional Approval vide Unique Registration No. ABFTS7614EF20231 dated 09.05.2023.

During the period under the present report, necessary contacts and detailed discussions were held with different social service organisations in and around Madhampatti in order to finalise the social activities. Regular meetings of the Trustees were held and the trustees were apprised of the activities conducted and the financial position during the respective periods under report for their concurrence and approval.

The Trustees by virtue of their previous knowledge and experience of working in close collaboration with some of the well known and deserving registered social service organizations decided to support primarily the poor people in the following areas viz., Annadanam, Educational and Vocational Support, Medical Support, Improvement of facilities at the local Panchayat School and Spiritual & Religious Services.

1. Annadanam: Distribution of prepared food was done twice a month to 70 poor and mentally retarded inmates of Sree Anbalayam Rehabilitation Centre at Sakthi Vinayaga Garden, Kuppanur, Madhampatti, Coimbatore-641010 managed by Sree Anbalayam Charitable Trust (Regd). Lunch or dinner was provided with sumptuous meal. Mr & Mrs Sanjiv Ray of Aishwaryam Senior Citizens Home in Karadimadai and Dr and Mrs Basker of Serene Shenbagham volunteered to help during the Annadanams. The Managing Trustee of Anbalayam Mrs. Srikala and the inmates, expressed their profound gratitude to our Trust and requested for its continuation. They have also sent a proposal for construction of a covered dining hall with proper flooring. The proposal is under consideration. Pictures and videos were taken on the different occasions.

2. Educational & Vocational Support to the poor: In the beginning of the financial year, regular monthly financial support was extended to the Kalvi Thunai Public Charitable Trust helping 250 poor students. After the joining of Dr. A. Basker and Mrs.P. Subha Basker of our Trust from 28th November 2023 onwards special classes in Chemistry and Mathematics were held for the XI & XII class for economically weaker students from nearby Govt schools. In addition, they also conducted coaching classes to 17 Hr.Sec. and 2 B.Com students enrolled in Kalvi Thunai. Their services have been appreciated by Kalvi Thunai Management.

Our Trust has received requests from the Panchayat Elementary School at Madhampatti for repairs and upkeep of student urinals, white washing of class rooms, covering the roof of class rooms with water proofing, door for the kitchen and appointment of an Ayah for cleaning the class rooms for younger students. Mr.& Mrs. Basker and Mrs.Geetha of our Trust will visit the school and discuss with the school authorities and present a report based on which our support will be decided.

3. Medical Support to the poor: Financial support was provided to Sri Vengusapriya Saibaba Anandhashrama Trust for its activities at their free Clinic in Theethipalayam, benefitting a large number of poor people including the tribal population in the surrounding villages. Dr. Natarajan, in view of his long experience in serving the aged people was consulted by Dr. Rajith, Geriatrician in charge for improving the facilities at a recently created Palliative Care Centre at the PSG Hospital for poor senior citizens suffering from chronic ailments. Dr. Rajith appreciated the suggestions.

Based on the request of the Sri Vengusapriya Saibaba Anandhashrama Trust for meeting the persistent demand of several patients, our Trust donated a sum of Rs. 75,000 for the purchase of an ECG monitor and accessories for regular use at the Saibaba Clinic which has since been installed and used regularly.

4. Spiritual & Religious Services: Our Trust is located in a Senior Citizens' Community in which there is a population of about 150-200 people majority being more than 70 yrs of age with some or the other disease problem or disability restricting their mobility and keeping them depressed. In order to improve their health and spiritual needs an old Siva temple in the campus has been renovated by our Trust with regular Puja activities both in the morning and evening with chanting of Sivastuthies and Veda parayanams, Pradosha Pujas twice a month and Ganapathi homam on the first day of every Tamil month. Special Puja was done for Arudra Dharisanam on 27th December,2023 and Maha

Shivaratri festival was celebrated on 8th March,2024 following the prescribed procedures. The requirement of flowers for pujas are largely met from the surrounding garden the maintenance and upkeep of which is being done satisfactorily.

5. Other supporting activities: The Trust activities have been authenticated through photographs and videos for record and publicity. Efforts are being made for designing the Webpage for our Trust with necessary writeups, pictures and videos of our activities for wider publicity. This work is expected to be completed in the next few months. In this connection, the voluntary support extended by Mrs. Sampada and Mrs Devshri of Surat, Gujarat is gratefully acknowledged.

The financial details on the Investments by our Trust and details of Trustees, photographs and videos on Annadanam, Educational and Vocational support to Kalvi Thunai, Clinical Laboratory Support to Sri Vengusapriya Saibaba Anandhashrama Trust and Sivaratri celebrations at Sri Shenbagha Lingeshwarar Temple have been attached below.

The video links on our activities uploaded in YouTube have also been included in this report.

The Trust is regularly receiving donations from many philanthropists and kind hearted persons to fund its charitable activities. If the Trust is granted Permanent Approval u/s 80 G (5) it will be in a position to mobilize more funds for its future activities as contemplated. Considering the genuineness of the activities of the Trust and to help it in the furtherance of its objectives, we request that Permanent Approval u/s 80G (5) may kindly be granted.




